RESOLUTION APPOINTING PAMELA G. BRITT AS LEE COUNTY REGISTER OF DEEDS

WHEREAS, Mollie McInnis retired from her elected position as Lee County Register of Deeds on December 1, 2014 after 37 years in service to the County; and,

WHEREAS, North Carolina General Statutes §§ 161-5(a1) states that “when a vacancy occurs...in the office of register of deeds, the board of county commissioners shall fill such vacancy by the appointment of a successor for the unexpired term, who shall qualify and give bond as required by law;” and,

WHEREAS, North Carolina General Statutes §§ 161-5(a1) further states that “[i]f the register of deeds was elected as the nominee of a political party, the board of county commissioners shall consult the county executive committee of that political party before filling the vacancy and shall appoint the person recommended by that committee, if the party makes a recommendation within 30 days of the occurrence of the vacancy;” and,

WHEREAS, the executive committee of the Lee County Democratic party has recommended that Pamela G. Britt be appointed Lee County Register of Deeds to fulfill the remainder of Ms. McInnis’s unexpired term.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Lee County Board of Commissioners that Pamela G. Britt is hereby appointed Lee County Register of Deeds for the remainder of Ms. McInnis’s unexpired term at a salary of \$55,000.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Lee County shall post the requisite bond for Ms. Britt as required by law.
