Position Title: Summer Camp Counselor

Salary Range: \$7.25/hour (25 and 40 hour a week positions available)

Overall Responsibilities: To create and carry out activities for children 4-12 years old.

Duties:

- Creates weekly activity plans for summer camp.
- Carries out activities with campers.
- Presents a positive image of San-Lee Park and Lee County Parks and Recreation.
- Enforces policies, rules, and regulations of San-Lee Park

Supervision:

- Reports directly to the Outdoor Education Specialist.
- Supervises children attending summer camp.

Relationships and Key Contacts:

- Has frequent contact with parents dropping off/picking up their kids.
- Has frequent contact with volunteers, other employees, and co-workers.

Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities:

- Ability to work with peers.
- Ability to supervise children in a fun and safe setting.
- Knowledge of games, crafts, and other camp activities.
- Willingness to learn about various nature topics, new games, new crafts, etc.
- Skill to operate a motorized vehicle.
- Skill to operate different types of tools.
- Ability to be flexible in all aspects of the job.
- Ability to communicate effectively with children, their parents, supervisors and co-workers.
- Ability to act quickly and calmly in emergencies.
- Must have previous experience working with children and be 18 years or older.

Preferred but not required:

- CPR/AED
- Life Guard

Working Conditions:

Physical: Must be physically able to operate a variety of machinery and equipment including computers, copiers, calculators, fax machines, garden implements, etc. Must be able to exert up to 50 pounds or more of force occasionally, and/or up to 25 pounds of force frequently, and/or a negligible amount of force constantly to move objects as well as children. Physical demand is in excess of those for sedentary work. Work requires walking, standing, lifting, bending, kneeling, stooping, and crawling to a significant degree.

Exposures: Must be able to work around hazardous substances including bleach, paint, glues, various solvents, etc. May be exposed to blood borne pathogens. May be exposed to outdoor elements for varying amount of time throughout the summer months.
