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ITEMS APPROVED AND ACTION TAKEN BY THE LEE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

Lee County Board of Commissioners
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The Lee County Board of Commissioners met at 5 p.m. on this date in a special called meeting and took action on the following:

- Approved low bid from FSC II, LLC d/b/a Fred Smith Company, Raleigh, North Carolina, in the amount of \$1,041,701.00 contingent upon the concurrence of the award by the US Department of Commerce Economic Development Administration, for the Clyde Rhyne Drive roadway extension project at the Lee County Industrial Park.

The Lee County Board of Commissioners and Lee County Board of Education met at 5:30 p.m. for a joint meeting.

- Superintendent Andy Bryan gave an overview of the school system vision.
- Approved for an inter-local agreement to be drawn up between the Board of Education and Lee County to cover agreed upon transfer of funds from the Schools to the County for seven (7) additional School Resource Officer positions.
- The Central Carolina Works project between Lee County, Chatham County, and Harnett County Schools was discussed. No action taken.
- The Board of Education provided their Capital Improvements Program (CIP) for FY 2014-15 through FY 2018-19. Additional projects requested include a second elementary school with gym and land, East Lee and West Lee Middle School gym expansions, and an auditorium to be constructed at Southern Lee High School. No action taken.
- Approved joint application to use Lottery funds for the replacement of air handlers and electric heat at East Lee Middle School. Total project is expected to cost \$1,284,000.
- Discussed teacher retention issues/teacher and teacher assistant supplements – No action taken.

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
