#### Declaring December 1, 2015 As Oscar Keller Day

**WHEREAS**, as a pioneer in the healthcare industry, Mr. Keller took every opportunity to extend his service to the College by employing Central Carolina Community College nursing graduates.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Lee County Board of Commissioners does hereby recognize Mr. Oscar Keller for his service to Lee County and Central Carolina Community College.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the first day of December 2015 will be recognized as **OSCAR KELLER DAY** in Lee County, North Carolina.
