RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE NORTH CAROLINA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO CONDUCT A TRAFFIC/SPEED STUDY IN THE LEE COUNTY INDUSTRIAL PARK

WHEREAS, The North Carolina Department of Transportation accepted the Clyde Rhyne Road Extension (S.R. 1476) located between Colon Road (SR 1415) and Womack Road (SR 1464) into the State's road maintenance system; and

WHEREAS, the North Carolina Department of Transportation already maintains Womack Road, Clyde Rhyne Road, Elwin Buchanan Drive, Rex McLeod Drive and Oak Park Road in the Lee County Industrial Park, which is not owned by the Lee County Government; and


WHEREAS, due to recent growth and expansion within the Industrial Park both pedestrian and vehicle traffic has increased greatly; and

WHEREAS, the newly formed Lee County Industrial Park Tenants Association identified vehicle speed within the park as a critical safety issue; and

WHEREAS, the Lee County Economic Development Corporation has received several statements of concern about the 55 mile an hour speed limit on the new section of Clyde Rhyne Road.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Lee County Board of Commissioners that pursuant to Chapter 3 of the North Carolina Traffic Ordinance Manual, the Division of Highways is hereby requested to review the speed of all roads within the Lee County Industrial Park, especially Clyde Rhyne Road, and to lower the speed limits by posting a safe speed within the Park.
