
JUNE 27, 2013

The Town Hall Community meeting of the Board of Commissioners for the County of Lee, State of North Carolina, convened at 7 p.m., at the Broadway Community Center located on Broadway Road, Broadway, North Carolina, on said date for the purpose of receiving input from citizens on the Lee County Economic Strategic Plan. Commissioners present were Amy M. Dalrymple, Charles T. Parks, Kirk D. Smith, and James K. Womack. County Manager John Crumpton was also present. A total of 20 citizens, including Commissioners and staff were in attendance.

Chairman Parks welcomed everyone and explained that the Commissioners were looking for input from businesses and private citizens on the Economic Strategic Plan that will be finalized in August.

Mr. Dan Parks from Small Business & Technology Center (SBTDC) presented information previously collected from Commissioners and citizens of Lee County prior to the last county election in November.
