The Town Hall Community meeting of the Board of Commissioners for the County of Lee, State of North Carolina, convened at 7 p.m., in the gym of the Deep River Elementary School located at 7908 Deep River Road, Sanford, North Carolina, on said date for the purpose of receiving input from citizens on the Lee County Economic Strategic Plan. Commissioners present were Charles T. Parks, Kirk D. Smith, and James K. Womack. Clerk to the Board Gaynell Lee was also present. A total of 25 citizens, including Commissioners, staff, and private citizens were in attendance.

Chairman Parks welcomed everyone and explained that the Commissioners were looking for input from businesses and private citizens on the Economic Strategic Plan that will be finalized in August.

Graphs and charts showing collected data were shared and discussed. Various members of the audience provided feedback and suggestions for the Plan.
