
WHEREAS, money raised during Relay for Life of Lee County supports the American Cancer society’s mission of saving lives and creating a world with less cancer and more birthdays; and,

WHEREAS, the American Cancer Society funded more than \$150 million in cancer research last year through money raised in communities across the Unites States.


