

The quarterly joint meeting of the Lee County Board of Commissioners, Lee County Economic Development Corporation (EDC), Sanford City Council, and Broadway Town Commissioners, convened at 10 a.m. at the McSwain Extension Education & Agriculture Center, 2420 Tramway Road, Sanford, North Carolina, on said date. Commissioners present Charles T. Parks, Kirk D. Smith, and James K. Womack. Staff in attendance included County Manager John Crumpton and Clerk to the Board Gaynell Lee.

Crystal Morphis, Interim Economic Development Director welcomed everyone. Ms. Morphis turned the meeting over to Mr. Mike Chadsey from the Ohio Oil and Gas Association. Mr. Chadsey discussed some of the issues Ohio faced when they began horizontal drilling and hydraulic fracturing. He stressed the importance of training such as welding, which is a highly paid job in this industry and the need for truck drivers. It was stated that welders could make as much as six figures for working six to nine months a year. Services such as restaurants and hotels will see an increase once drilling begins in an area.

The meeting adjourned at 10:50 a.m.
