RESOLUTION

TO PLACE 4-WAY STOP SIGN AT THE INTERSECTION OF CARBONTON ROAD AND STEEL BRIDGE ROAD

WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation (DOT) serves the State of North Carolina by ensuring a fast, safe, efficient, accessible and convenient transportation system that meets our vital national interests and enhances the quality of life of the citizens of North Carolina, today and into the future; and,

WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation has conducted a traffic study of the intersection at Carbonton Road and Steel Bridge Road; and,

WHEREAS, the completed study shows this intersection to be dangerous for traffic entering the intersection due to the obstruction of trees blocking the view and lack of site distance of oncoming traffic and the way in which the road is constructed; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Department of Transportation to place 4-way stop signs at the designated intersection; and,

WHEREAS, the Lee County Board of Commissioners is of the opinion that 4-way stop signs should be added to the intersection of Carbonton Road and Steel Bridge Road to reduce a dangerous traffic situation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the County of Lee that the Division of Highways is hereby requested to place 4-way stop signs at the intersection of Carbonton Road and Steel Bridge Road in Sanford (Lee County) as soon as possible.
