No one was present to make public comments.



Shane Seagroves gave a brief outlook on hurricane season 2017, while showing a visual of the path of current tropical storm Cindy. He stated that now was a good time to prepare in advance for risks by reviewing emergency plans and building/restocking ready kits in case of an evacuation. Shane also encouraged everyone to sign up for CodeRED®, the county's reverse 911 emergency notification system, if they have not already done so.
