The Lee County Local Emergency Planning Committee met on March 30, 2016 at Lee County Emergency Services, 204 West Courtland Drive, Sanford, NC.

Chairman Roger Tankersley called the meeting to order at 11:39 a.m. and welcomed everyone; individual introductions followed.

A motion was made by Kimberly Killian to accept the meeting minutes, as presented, from the December 16, 2015 meeting; seconded by Wayne Barber; unanimous vote.

Chairman Tankersley asked for a motion to approve the agenda, as so altered; motion made by Kimberly Killian, seconded by David Vann; motion carried unanimously.

No one was present to make public comments.

Shannon Cagle, Lee County Health Department, updated the committee on the "Bright Ideas" grant and provided information and handouts referencing the Zika virus. (copy attached)

Scott Fister announced that Caterpillar Appreciation Day is going to be held at their facility on May 21st. The committee discussed the possibility of educational resources and service offerings within Lee County that could tie in with the event. 
