We do this with reluctance, but with the health and well-being of our participants in mind.

If you would like to donate your fee to the Shuffleboard Court refinishing fund, that is also an option.

The North Carolina Senior Games Board of Directors and staff are committed to providing a path to any potential State Finals events if it is deemed safe to have those events in the fall. Remember, 2020 is a qualifying year for 2021 Nationals in Fort Lauderdale, Florida, if it is deemed safe to do so in 2021. Let's hope this virus will be defeated in time to have State Finals and National Senior Games!
